**THE REPORT OF  
THE KENTUCKY CONFERENCE BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

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*Your Kentucky Conference Board of Trustees begs leave to present the following report...*

Per the Doctrine and Discipline, the Board of Trustees met the meeting requirements, and the following business was executed:

Saint Andrew Winchester, affirmed (at a meeting of their Church Conference and Quarterly Conference on January 21, 2018) their desire to dissolve as a congregation. Per the charge of the 150<sup>th</sup> Session of the Kentucky Annual Conference, the Conference Board of Trustees were empowered to sell the Saint Andrews property if they “fail to display a will to continue as a congregation”. The property was sold for \$8,000.00, and the Kentucky Conference has received the balance of the bank account in the amount of \$26.69.

The Saint Paul Louisville Church and Parsonage properties were sold for the amount of \$50,000.00 (\$25,000.00 each, respectively).

Ward Chapel Scottsville was assisted in the amount of \$1,500.00, to aid in necessary repairs.

Allen Chapel Moreland’s Church property and edifice were devastated by flood. The Kentucky Conference assisted them with \$6000.00 to aid in its restoration, but further developments in the damage assessment has shown that further funding will be necessary to restore the edifice. We have no recommendation to make at this time.

And, the Wilson Chapel Church School, and Cemetery property’s sale is pending.

The Conference Board of Trustees recommends the following: Now that the Saint Paul Owensboro church edifice has been razed, it is our request that this 151<sup>st</sup> Session of the Kentucky Annual Conference empower the Conference Board of Trustees to sell the property.
