- ❖ Dress for Zoom participants on Wednesday & Thursday may be business casual.
- ❖ Clergy are to wear clergy shirts for the Opening and Closing Worship. Jackets optional. Preacher may be robed.

- ❖ Saturday dress should be business attire.
- ❖ Component Reports should be video recorded and sent to the bishop's office. The Reports should be no longer than 3-5 minutes.
- ❖ Clergy and Lay Delegates will be invited to participate through Zoom. Observers will be encouraged to use Facebook Live and YouTube.
