What were the goals for the last conference year?

1. To complete the CKD-SOA slate of district officers with a Secretary.
2. To sponsor a retreat for the YPD of the ETC.
3. Develop a strategy to minister and promote spiritual growth to the men within our churches in both districts.

What was accomplished on the annual conference level?

1. The ETC-SOA participated in the Angel Tree Prison Ministries providing Christmas for approximately 90 children.
1. Overall the SOA units within the conference increased their ministry in the church and community.
2. In December 2018, the FPD partnered with the clergy performing a holiday worship service at Mt. View Winchester.
3. FPD provided gifts to under-privileged families in the area.
4. FPD gave out "back to school" backpacks to students.
5. CKD - St. Paul (Alcoa) added two new SOA members.

6. CKD - Bethel (Knox.) sponsored their annual "Sweetheart Breakfast" to the women of the church for Valentines.
7. CKD - Bethel (Knox.) sponsored an "Empty Stocking Fund" for the senior citizens in the low income area of Knoxville giving out 120 food baskets. The baskets were delivered by the SOA men of the church and community volunteers.
8. CKD - Bethel (Knox.) is rebuilding the church library.
9. CKD - Bethel (Knox.) Donated 6 each \$50 gift cards to high school students at a local high school for Angel Tree in addition to the 50 plus gifts cards they issued for the Angel Tree Prison Ministries Program.
10. CKD - Bethel (Knox.) is installing in the church an electronic chairlift for the handicapped.
11. CKD - Bethel (Chatt.) Served breakfast to the community every third Sunday morning of the month before Church School.
12. CKD - Bethel (Chatt.) installed hardwood flooring and bulletin boards in the church foyer.
13. CKD - Bethel (Chatt.) installing sheetrock over plywood walls in kitchen area and hallway in the annex.
14. CKD - Bethel (Chatt.) installed "Church Parking Only" signs in the church parking lot.
15. CKD - Warren Chapel sponsored a trip to Atlanta, GA for male youths to a professional basketball game and Black historical tour of the Martin Luther King Center, the Sweet Auburn Ave., and Martin Luther King's home.
16. CKD - Warren Chapel gave Christmas bags with personal items to the male youths of the church.
17. CKD - Warren Chapel sponsored a "Movie Theater Evening" at the church for the male youths of the church.
18. CKD - Warren Chapel sponsored its "Annual Community Barbecue".
19. CKD - Warren Chapel participated in the ETC Angel Tree Prison Ministries Program.
20. CKD - Warren Chapel sponsored their annual "Mother's Day Breakfast" for the mothers of the church.
21. CKD - Warren Chapel purchased their SOA uniforms all except for their trousers.

6. Repeat participating in the "Angel Tree" Prison Ministries Christmas Program this year by increasing the number of children that we give to in the program.
7. Sponsor an ETC-SOA Weekend Retreat to allow the ETC-SPA brothers the opportunity to worship, fish, golf, bond and enjoy each other each other.
